




ARTICLE 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2. Shall the Town vote to approve a Moratorium Ordinance on Quarries and Mineral Extraction. This Moratorium shall be in effect for a period of 180 days from April 8th, 2014 or until the effective date the Quarries and Mineral Extraction Ordinance is passed at a Special Town Meeting whichever is earlier, unless extended by the Board of Selectmen pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. §4356.
